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

RE: Capital Bridge Bill – Senate Bill 1503 Amendment

Pursuant to recent correspondence from Senator Roger Madigan, Chairman of the Senate Transportation Committee, it is my understanding that an extensive amendment to Senate Bill 1503, the Highway-Railroad and Highway Bridge Bill for 2008-2009, will be introduced upon our return to Harrisburg in September. This amendment will add a number of state and local bridge projects to the current capital bridge legislation in order that they may be authorized and ultimately proceed forward.

A listing of local and state bridges in the 40th District already included in the amendment has been attached hereto for your reference. If there are any additional bridge projects within your municipality that you believe should be included in SB 1503, information regarding the same may be submitted by to Brian Litzinger or Drew Miller of my district office staff at your earliest convenience. In doing so, please note that I must submit all potential projects to the Transportation Committee on or before August 28th. **CONSEQUENTLY, ALL ADDITIONAL INCLUSIONS MUST BE FORWARDED TO MY STAFF ON OR BEFORE AUGUST 26TH.** I would caution you that bridge projects currently in progress, authorized by a previous capital bill, or already included in the amendment do not need to be added to the proposed legislation.

Because this bill will allow more of our aging and deteriorated bridges to be addressed, your input is critically appreciated.
